

As you know, the federal government is gearing up to hire workers to conduct the census. Most of these jobs pay \$15 per hour for up to 30 hours a week for approximately 15 weeks or more. There are also some full-time, temporary jobs. They plan to hire at least 12,000 people upstate and I am sure that the downstate numbers are at least as high. Some of the hiring is through our One-stop system and there is a basic employment test that people have to take. I thought that you would be interested in sharing this with your affiliates especially if they know workers who have run out of unemployment.
